

When fitting your Powerbronze product it will help you to use your motorcycle manual for disassembly and reassembly of your motorcycle. You will need a set of spanners, sockets, torques keys, Allen keys & screwdrivers.


Taking a few moments to check the parts list and familiarising yourself with the kit will make fitting easier. Remember; whenever a part is fixed by using several nuts, bolts or screws they should be left loose until all are in place and then tightened

### Remove original bar ends Remove protective film from hand guards

Fit bar end assembly to both hand guards.
 Do not tighten up the screw at this stage. Fig.1




2. Fit grommets (6) into the hand guards and spacers (7) into grommets. Fig.2




3. Fit brackets (2 & 3) to mirror supports by removing mirror, positioning brackets on top of original spacer and replacing mirror. Fig.3 & 4




4. Fit hand guards using bar end inserts and tighten M6 x 40 cap socket screw. Fit the hand guards to the brackets using M6 x 20 (4) M6 Flange nut (5). Fig 5



5. Check lever operation insuring no resistance and that they clear the hand guards. Fig. 6





**NOTE:** The best position for the hand guards can be achieved by rotating the bar end and rotating the LH and RH Brackets.

#### IMPORTANT: Always check alignment of hand guards and mounting bolt tension periodically.
